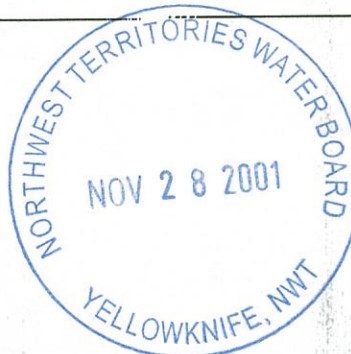

Re: **Shell Canada Ltd. Winter 2001/2002 Aklavik 2D Seismic Program Water License Application.**

Shell's original application to the NWT Water Board indicated that a Filterboxx system would be used to treat the wastewater generated by the sleigh camp during their winter 2001/2002 program. Since the submission of the application, Shell has decided to haul all of the wastewater generated by their sleigh camp back to Inuvik for disposal in the municipal lagoon. No wastewater will be discharged in the program area. This letter is to request that the water license currently under review be issued solely on the basis of the withdrawal requirements for the sleigh camp and hauling of wastewater to Inuvik for disposal. We apologize for any inconvenience this may have caused.
