Re: N7L3-1619 - Hamlet of Paulatuk, Municipal Water Licence – 2017 Annual Report


The Inuvialuit Water Board (IWB) acknowledges receipt of the 2017 annual report submitted by the Hamlet of Paulatuk on June 7, 2018. The IWB has completed a review of the 2017 annual report and as a result, information gaps have been identified. As per water licence N7L3-1619 Terms and Conditions, please provide the following additional information:

1. Part B, Item 1 c): as per annual report template item 3) the annual report indicates locations of “Waste Oil” and “Batteries” transported off site. There is no information regarding the quantities transported off site and/or stored on site. Please provide a summary of the monthly and annual quantities of hazardous waste stored on site and transported off site;
2. Part B, Item 1 f): as per annual report template item 6) tabular summaries of all data generated under the “Surveillance Network Program (SNP) sampling stations:
 - 1619-2: Effluent discharge from existing sewage disposal facilities before entering adjacent wetland;
 - 1619-3: Effluent discharge from adjacent wetland of existing sewage disposal facilities before entering Darnley Bay;
 - 1619-4: Effluent discharge from abandoned sewage lagoon before entering Darnley Bay;
 - 1619-5: Run-off from existing solid waste disposal facilities; and
 - 1619-6: Run-off from existing solid waste disposal facilities before entering old water lake.
3. Part B, Item 1 k): as per annual report template item 11) any updates and/or revisions to the:
 - approved Spill Contingency Plan;
 - approved Solid Waste Disposal Facilities Operation and Maintenance Plan;

- approved Sewage Waste Disposal Facilities Operation and Maintenance Plan;
 - approved Hazardous Waste Management Plan;
 - approved Closure and Reclamation Plan.
4. Part B, Item 1 n): as per annual report template item 14) the inclusion of all correspondence between the inspector and the Licensee; and
 5. Part B, Item 1 o): as per annual report template item 15) any other details on waste disposal requested by the Board by November 1 of the year being reported.

The above information is a requirement of the annual report submissions and a condition of the water licence. Please submit this information as soon as possible to maintain compliance of your current water licence.
