The Inuvialuit Water Board (IWB) acknowledges receipt of the 2018 Environmental Site Monitoring Report. Upon review, information gaps were noted as required by Water Licence N7L1-1815 Part B: General Conditions, Item 1. The submitted environmental site monitoring report only satisfies the requirement of Part B, Item 1h.

Please provide the following information:

2. Part B, Item 1b): the total quantities in cubic metres of each and all waste discharged;
3. Part B, Item 1c): the location and direction of flow of all waste discharged to the land or water;
4. Part B, Item 1d): an itemized list indicating the names and quantities of all drilling mud additives used;
5. Part B, Item 1e): details of work completed;
6. Part B, Item 1f): details on the restoration of any sumps;
7. Part B, Item 1g): a list of spills and unauthorized discharges; and
8. Part B, Item 1i): any other details on water use or waste disposal requested by the Board within forty-five (45) days before the annual report is due.

Please submit two (2) hard copies and two (2) electronic copies (CD's or USB's) of the above additional information requested. Submitted documentation, including all related IWB correspondence, will be placed on the IWB Public Register.
