The Inuvialuit Water Board (IWB) is in receipt of the N7L1-1787 – Langley K30 Drilling Sump 2018 Environmental Site Monitoring Report submitted by MGM Energy on behalf of the Chevron Canada. The IWB provide the following comments regarding this file.

- Water Licence N7L1-1787 expired on November 30, 2007;
- N7L1-1787 Condition Part H - Item 2) The Licensee shall monitor the drilling waste sump after closure for a period of three (3) years during the thaw season. According to our records, the sump was closed in 2003. This condition has been completed by the Licensee, therefore, no further Environmental Site Monitoring Reports are required.

All submitted documentation, including related IWB correspondence will be placed on the IWB Public Register.
