
**Re: N5L8-1837 – Repsol Oil & Gas Canada Inc. – Panarctic F-68 Abandoned Wellsite,
Satellite Bay, NWT – Modification Request**

The Inuvialuit Water Board (IWB) acknowledges receipt on August 26, 2019 of the modification request documents submitted by IMG Golder on behalf of Repsol Oil & Gas Inc. including the technical memorandum, site plan and engineered drawings for a lined and bermed temporary water storage area. The IWB accepts the modification request as submitted subject to the following provisions as per water licence N5L8-1837:

- Part F: Conditions Applying to Waste Management and Disposal, Item 13 - The Licensee shall dispose of all contaminated water that does not meet effluent criteria at a licenced facility.
- Part J: Conditions Applying to Construction, Item 4 - The Licensee shall construct and operate all components of the Project designed to contain, treat, withhold, divert or retain water or waste in accordance with all applicable federal or territorial legislation and industry standards.
- Part K: Conditions Applying to Reclamation, Closure and Monitoring Plan, Item 3 - Upon completion of all activities, the Licensee shall ensure that all materials, equipment, temporary structures and debris are removed from the site. Other final restoration activities as may be outlined in the Project Description shall be implemented to the satisfaction of the inspector.
