RE: N7L1-1836 – Imperial Oil Resources, Remediation of BAR-C, Tununuk Point, NWT – Water Licence Renewal Reminder


This letter is to remind Imperial Oil Resources (IOR) that the water licence N7L1-1836 BAR-C, Tununuk Point, NWT remediation project expires on March 30, 2020. The 2017 Annual Report reported wide cracks on the sides and on the top of the rehabilitated landfills A and B and is also identified in an inspection report submitted by Environment and Natural Resources (ENR) Water Resource Officer (WRO) on September 13, 2018. In order to assess the long-term integrity of the rehabilitated landfills A and B, a Phase II post-construction monitoring (as described in the Monitoring Plan) is required. The Inuvialuit Water Board (IWB) recommends IOR submit a water licence renewal application (Schedule C) and include the following documents:

- Environmental Impact Screening Committee (EISC) Decision Letter for the renewal of the project;
- Consultation Records from meetings with the Aklavik Community Corporation, Aklavik Hunters and Trappers Committee, Tuktoyaktuk Community Corporation, Tuktoyaktuk Hunters and Trappers Committee, Inuvik Community Corporation, and Inuvik Hunters and Trappers Committee; and
- A thirty-dollar (\$30.00) application fee payable to Government of the Northwest Territories (GNWT).

The IWB requires a renewal application (Schedule C) and supporting documents in advance of the licence expiry date. If a water licence renewal application (Schedule C) and associated documents are not received prior to the expiry date, the Board may renew the water licence on its own initiative in accordance with the *Waters Act* s.36(1)(a)(ii).

Please submit two (2) hard copies and two (2) electronic (CD's or USB's) copies of all submissions to the IWB office in Inuvik. Submitted documents, including all related IWB correspondence, will be placed on the IWB Public Register.
