Gunghi Creek Crossing Replacement**

On behalf of the Government of the Northwest Territories, Department of Infrastructure, Wood Environment and Infrastructure Solutions (Wood) is pleased to submit this application for water licence for the proposed Gunghi Creek Crossing Replacement works, located along the Inuvik to Tuktoyaktuk Highway at km marker 131.2 (Zone 8W, 577222.00 m E, 7693944.00 m N), approximately 14 km south of Tuktoyaktuk.

The existing culvert crossing structure has major sagging in the center and requires replacement. The Gunghi Creek crossing is also located in a permafrost rich area prone to major icing that contributes to culvert ice plugging which additionally undermines and endangers the crossing embankments. We respectfully request this Water Licence Application undergo expedited review, wherever possible, to allow replacement works to occur in the February 2020, where construction is proposed to commence on February 15, 2020 with a completion date of April 15, 2020.


