Re: N7L3-1619 - Hamlet of Paulatuk, Municipal Water Licence - 2019 Annual Report


The Inuvialuit Water Board (IWB) acknowledges receipt of the above-mentioned report received on March 23, 2020. Upon review, information gaps have been identified. As per water licence N7L3-1619, please provide the following additional information:

1. Part B, Item 1 f): Surveillance Network Program (SNP) station numbers 1619-2, 1619-3 and 1619-4 are included with annual report. As described under water licence Annex A, SNP results of stations 1619-5 and 1619-6 are also required to be submitted. Therefore, provide tabular summaries of all data generated under the SNP sampling stations 1619-5 (Run-off from Existing Solid Waste Disposal Facilities); and 1619-6 (Run-off from Existing Solid Waste Disposal Facilities before entering Old Water Lake).
2. Part B, Item 1 m): Provide information regarding yearly inspections conducted by the Hamlet Staff on all water and waste disposal facilities authorized under this licence and any corrective actions, as necessary.

The above-mentioned information is a requirement of annual reporting and a condition of the water licence. The submitted documents, including all related IWB correspondence, will be placed on the IWB Public Register.
