**RE: N3L8-1844 – Northwestel Inc. (NWTel), Asset Removal - Taglu Microwave Tower Site, NWT – Water Licence Renewal Reminder**

The Inuvialuit Water Board (IWB) would like to remind NWTel that water licence N3L8-1844 for asset removal at the Taglu Microwave Tower Site is due to expire February 19, 2021. If the project is to be continued beyond the expiry date and a water licence is required, the IWB recommend NWTel submit a water licence renewal application (Schedule C) with the following documents:

- Environmental Impact Screening Committee (EISC) Decision Letter for the renewal of the project.
- Any updates to the approved Spill Contingency Plan, submit an updated Spill Contingency Plan including a summary of the updates; and
- A thirty-dollar (\$30.00) application fee payable to Government of the Northwest Territories (GNWT).

As indicated in the “General Procedure for the Administration of the Licences”, the IWB requires the receipt of a renewal application and supporting documents in advance of the licence expiry date. Please submit two (2) hard copies and two (2) electronic (USB’s) copies of all submissions to the IWB office in Inuvik. Submitted documents, including all related IWB correspondence, will be placed on the IWB Public Register.
