**RE: N7L1-1835 – GNWT, DEPARTMENT OF INFRASTRUCTURE (INF) – INUVIK TO TUKTOYAKTUK HIGHWAY (ITH) PROJECT**


The Inuvialuit Water Board (IWB) would like to remind GNWT INF that the following information is outstanding as required by Water Licence N7L1-1835:

1. Part C: Conditions Applying to Construction, Item 4 – The Licensee shall ensure that all Construction of Engineered Structures is supervised by an Engineer. The Licensee shall also ensure that for all Engineered Structures the following post-construction information is signed and stamped by an Engineer and submitted to the Board and an Inspector: Construction records, as-built documentation, and a summary of any deviations from original design that required Engineer approval. The postconstruction information shall be provided to the Board within ninety (90) days of completion of the Construction.
2. Schedule I: Surveillance Network Program (SNP), Part D, Item 1 - The Licensee shall, within thirty (30) days following the month being reported, submit to the Board and an Inspector all data and information required by the “Surveillance Network Program”.
3. GNWT INF - ITH 2019 / 2020 Annual Report - Additional information requested July 7, 2020.

In accordance with Water Licence N7L1-1835 Part B, Item 11 and the IWB Document Submission Standards (available on IWB website [www.inuvwb.ca](http://www.inuvwb.ca) at link: [https://www.inuvwb.ca/sites/default/files/200401\\_iwb\\_document\\_submission\\_standards.pdf](https://www.inuvwb.ca/sites/default/files/200401_iwb_document_submission_standards.pdf)) the Licensee shall submit two (2) copies of all reports, plans, maps and drawings in printed format accompanied by two (2) electronic copies (CDs or USBs) including a cover letter, signed and dated, with reference to water licence number and indicating the licence condition the information is being submitted under.
