Re: NWTWB Public Hearings Inuvik – Tuktoyaktuk Highway Application N7-1-1835


As you will be aware from our previous correspondence the NWT Water Board (the Board) is presently engaged in the assessment of an application from the GNWT, Department of Transportation for the above-noted highway development application.

As an important element of this assessment, the Board will convene public hearings in Inuvik on October 7, 2013 and in Tuktoyaktuk on October 8, 2013 commencing at 9:00 a.m. on both days.

In our review, the Board recognizes the value and importance of gaining an understanding of how the traditional uses of water by Inuvialuit along the proposed highway route may be impacted by the project. To this end the Board would like to invite you, or a person designated by you, to attend the hearing scheduled for Tuktoyaktuk and speak to the Board on these matters, particularly as they relate to traditional knowledge and views on water use and conservation.
