Re: Inclusion on Distribution List and Participation in Proceeding



Dear Mr. ^{Eddie}Dillon,

The Inuvialuit Game Council (the "IGC") has recently become aware of the Government of the Northwest Territories' application for a Type "A" Water License in relation to the Inuvik to Tuktoyaktuk Highway (the "ITH") Water Licensing Proceeding. The IGC was established under the Inuvialuit Final Agreement (the "IFA") to represent the collective interest of the Inuvialuit in fish and wildlife. It is the understanding of the IGC that the ITH project will affect the flow and quality of water, in and around Husky Lakes.

Husky Lakes is an area of significant traditional importance to the Inuvialuit. Many Beneficiaries of the IFA have cabins in the area and continue to hunt, fish and trap there.

IGC understands that the deadline for providing notice of intention to intervene has passed. However, the reason we missed the deadline is because the NWT Water Board's distribution list for this matter did not include the IGC or any other Joint Secretariat authority responsible for the protection of fish and wildlife. If the IGC had been notified, we would have responded much earlier.

We are writing to request that the Board:

1. Include the IGC on the distribution list for all future correspondence in this matter; and
2. Allow us to participate in this proceeding with full party status.

IGC staff or legal counsel will be in contact with the Board in the coming days to determine the Board's response to this request.


IGC represents the collective interest of the Inuvialuit in wildlife, including fish, which will be affected by the construction and operation of the highway (licensed undertaking).

Will you be representing yourself or will someone else be representing you?


IGC will be represented by Counsel and our staff will work with them and the Board as the proceeding goes forward.
