Re: N7L3-1531 – Hamlet of Sachs Harbour Municipal Water Licence – 2014 Annual Report

The Inuvialuit Water Board (IWB) acknowledges receipt of the Annual Report submitted via fax by the Hamlet of Sachs Harbour on April 30, 2015. Upon review of the report, information gaps were noted as required by General Conditions Part B, Item 1 of the Water Licence. To address the information gaps please provide the following:

1. As required by Part B, Item 1c, provide a summary of the monthly and annual quantities of hazardous waste stored on site and transported off site.
2. According to Part B, Item 1d, provide monthly and annual quantities of sewage solids removed from the Sewage Disposal Facilities for disposal.
3. In accordance with Part B, Item 1e, information is required of any problems, modifications or repairs done to the Water Supply and Waste Disposal Facilities, including all associated structures.
4. As required by Part B, Item 1f, provide tabular summaries of all data generated under the "Surveillance Network Program". If sampling was not conducted and data not generated during the year of reporting as required by the Surveillance Network Program, provide reasons to the IWB.
5. In accordance with Part B, Item 1g, if spills and unauthorized discharges occurred, provide a list of those occurrences.
6. As required by Part B, Item 1h, provide an outline of any spill training and/or other operator training carried out during the year.
7. As per Part B, Item 1i, provide a summary of any closure and reclamation work completed during the year and an outline of any work anticipated for the next year.

8. Pursuant to Part B, Item 1j, provide a summary of any studies requested by the Board that relate to waste disposal, water use or reclamation and a brief description of any future studies planned.
9. As required by Part B, Item 1k, if there were any updates and/or revisions to the approved Spill Contingency Plan, Municipal Solid Waste Operations and Maintenance Plan, and Sewage Treatment Plan, provide updates and/or revisions of those plans.
10. As required by Part B, Item 1l, provide information of any other details on water use or waste disposal requested by the Board by November 1st of the year being reported.
