Thank you for your letter of June 8<sup>th</sup>, 2020, in which you request amendments to your previously screened and amended files EISC 03-18-02 and EISC 04-19-07.

The Environmental Impact Screening Committee (EISC) reviewed the original files, the amendment request to change the project duration to a multi-year period, updated Emergency Response Plans/ Spill Contingency Plans, and updated timelines of scheduled activities. The amendment applies to the proposed final demobilization phase for the Satellite Bay remediation project (EISC file 03-18-02) and consequently the removal of the reinforcement tiles from Mould Bay airstrip (EISC file 04-19-07).
