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INTRODUCTION

The Hamlet of Aklavik's Water Licence N3L4-0570 became effective May 1, 1989 and expires April 30, 1999. This report covers Aklavik's compliance with their Water Licence N3L4-0570 for the 1994 calendar year.

Refer to Water Licence N3L4-0570 for the actual wording of its terms and conditions.

INSPECTIONS

An inspection of Aklavik's water and waste disposal facilities on October 31, 1994, was conducted by Scott Gallupe, Water Resources Officer, Inuvik. The Licensee representatives for the inspection were Nellie Gruben, Senior Administrative Officer, Ron Sayers, Acting Hamlet Foreman and Roy Kasook, DPW/GNWT Maintenance Foreman.

WATER LICENCE N3L4-0570 1994 COMPLIANCE REVIEW

Part A: General Conditions

1. Scope: The scope of this Licence allows for municipal water use and waste disposal at Aklavik, Northwest Territories.

2. Definitions for the terms used in Water Licence N3L4-0570.

3. "The Licensee shall file a report pursuant to Section 12(1) of the Act and Section 15(1) of the Regulations not later than March 1st of the year following the calendar year to be reported which shall contain the following information:
 - a) annual quantity in cubic metres of water pumped from the Peel Channel of the Mackenzie River;

 - b) a detailed record of maintenance work carried out on the water supply and the waste disposal systems and all associated structures;

 - c) tabular summaries of all data generated under the Surveillance Network Program;

 - d) a description of any restoration or reclamation carried out at areas where water supply or waste disposal facilities have been abandoned;

 - e) the annual quantity of waste discharged to the Clearing Lake Sewage Lagoon.

Violation: The above information was not included with the 1994 Annual Report.

10. "The Licensee shall, within sixty (60) days of the issuance of this Licence, post signs in the area of the water supply facilities and in the areas of the waste disposal facilities to advise the public that these areas are being used for the municipal water supply and for the disposal of municipal wastes. All postings shall be located and maintained to the satisfaction of the Inspector."

Violation: The waste disposal facilities and the SNP stations were noted posted to the satisfaction of the Inspector.

Comment: This violation was also noted in the 1993 Compliance Report.

No violations were noted under this section of Water Licence N3L4-0570 for the 1994 calendar year.

Part C: **Conditions Applying to Waste Disposal**

No violations were noted under this section of Water Licence N3L4-0570 for the 1994 calendar year.

No violations were noted under this section of Water Licence N3L4-0570 for the 1994 calendar year.


D. **Reports**
