LICENCE AMENDMENT**

Pursuant to the *Waters Act* and Waters Regulations the Inuvialuit Water Board hereby grants the following Licence Amendment.

Part A: Scope and Definitions,

Item 1: Scope

- a) This Licence entitles the Licensee to use water and dispose of waste for the "industrial undertakings" (as per Schedule IV of the Regulations) associated with the remediation of BAR-C, Tununuk Point, NT as outlined in the application received November 26, 2013 and all supplemental information submitted to the Board prior to and including January 30, 2014 (titled: "N7-1-1836 Water License Application, Imperial Oil Resources Ltd., BAR-C DEW Line/IOR Tununuk Remediation Project, December 2013), and an Amendment Application (Schedule C - dated December 2, 2016 including the supplementary information – Dock Demolition and Reclamation Plan – October 26, 2016) submitted by the Licensee for removal of the BAR-C dock during Winter 2017 including the use of a sleigh camp with coordinates Latitude 69° 0' 44" N and 134° 40' 57" W.

Part C: Conditions Applying to Construction

7. To avoid the potential for serious harm to the receiving waters and environment, the mitigation measures listed below, in addition to those set out in your project plans, are to be followed:
- a) Stabilize the disturbed shoreline area using effective erosion and sediment control measures if it is determined that the shoreline is unstable during IOR's site visit in summer 2017.
 - b) Operate machinery in a manner that minimizes disturbance to the watercourse bed and banks;
 - c) Machinery is to arrive on site in a clean condition and is to be maintained free of fluid leaks; and
 - d) Wash, refuel and service machinery and store fuel and other materials for the machinery a minimum of 30 meters from the high water mark (even if covered by ice) to prevent deleterious substances from entering the water.

This Licence is amended and recorded at Inuvik, Northwest Territories.
